BACKYARD RIBFEST TEAM RULES

Location: Hill City, SD

Saturday August 24, 2019

Entry Fee: There is a \$50 entry fee, due on the 23rd, for each team that will cover the cost of the ribs and one Event Cup. Registration Limited to the first 20 teams!

<u>Ribs</u>: Each team will be provided up to 10 racks of Ribs for the competition upon registration at the Hill City Senior Center at 4:30 pm on Friday August 23rd.

<u>Time</u>: Backyard BBQ_Ribfest people's choice judging will begin at 11am on the 24th and will run until 1pm. Serving will continue until you run out of ribs. Any side dishes and beverages served are at the discretion of each rib team.

Alcohol: Alcohol is allowed within the boundaries of the Wine Brew and BBQ in an event cup only. Alcohol cannot be sold at Backyard BBO Ribfest booths.

<u>Weather</u>: The event will take place regardless of weather. Backyard BBQ_Ribfest Teams may set up at their discretion. Cancellation of the event is up to the judgment of the Backyard BBQ_Ribfest Committee. No Refunds will be given due to inclement weather.

<u>Site Preparation:</u> Site preparation will begin at 7:00 am on Friday. After 8:00 pm on Saturday vehicles will not be allowed in the Backyard BBQ_Ribfest area and items will need to be carried to assigned booth. Team booths will be assigned on Friday at 4:30pm. Teams will be able to bring in their large cookers on Friday.

<u>Trash</u>: Each team is responsible for providing 2 of their own 50 gallon garbage cans and liners at your booth. The city will have dumpsters conveniently located and available to all teams to dispose of their garbage. Each team should provide hand wipes and toothpicks.

<u>Electricity:</u> Because of restricted access to power, no power will be provided to Backyard BBQ_Ribfest Cookers. Please bring your own portable, quiet generators if power is needed.

<u>Gas & Coals:</u> All hot coals must be placed in the steel barrels near each booth. Each team must provide a UL listed connection for all propane tanks. Propane cooking tanks must be stored in grids at least 10 feet from the cooking area.

<u>Clean-up:</u> All contestants are responsible for keeping their space clean and sanitary and must have their booths deconstructed and removed from Competition area by 9:00 am Sunday.

Extra Ribs: Anyone with the capability to cook more than 10 racks of ribs may cook any extra ribs from the event supply to distribute after the people's choice has finished.

People's Choice and Rib sampling: Wine Brew and Barbeque patrons may participate in the people choice judging of the Backyard BBQ Ribfest by purchasing a wrist band and voting token for \$20 at a Wine Brew and Barbeque booth. For \$25 you can get a Ribfest package that also includes an event cup with a free first fill (saves \$5). The wristband will provide access to the Backyard BBQ Ribfest area where judges may have unlimited samples of ribs. Judges are encouraged to try one of each contestants ribs at a minimum. No one without a wristband will be allowed in the Backyard BBQ Ribfest area during judging. Beverages are allowed in an event cup. There will be soda and water available.

GENERAL RULES:

- 1. Proper storage of meat is required. It must be maintained below 40 degrees or above 140 degrees.
- 2. Your booth should have a free-flowing spigot container of water with an on/off valve and a catch container, hand soap and disposable towels for proper hand washing. A second container with bleach water should be kept for wiping counters, etc.
- 3. Booths are to be no more than 10x30 feet and must be positioned so that they sit up against the curb of the street. If you require more space for your setup, you're required to purchase an additional 10x10 space. Please consider the size of your setup, including the size of your trailer, cooker and serving area when registering. You will not be allowed to use the sidewalk behind your booth for storage.
- 4. Placement of your booth will be determined by the Backyard BBQ_Ribfest Committee.
- 5. Each team will be responsible for any equipment they might need such as table, tent, cover, etc.
- 6. Teams must provide their own safety inspected (5 lbs minimum) multi-purpose ABC dry chemical fire extinguisher.
